ARKADELPHIA, Ark. -- Ouachita Baptist University's Pruet School of Christian Studies will host its annual Seminary Day on Friday, Nov. 7, from 9 a.m. to 2 p.m. in Evans Student Center. The event is open to students of all majors and classifications.
