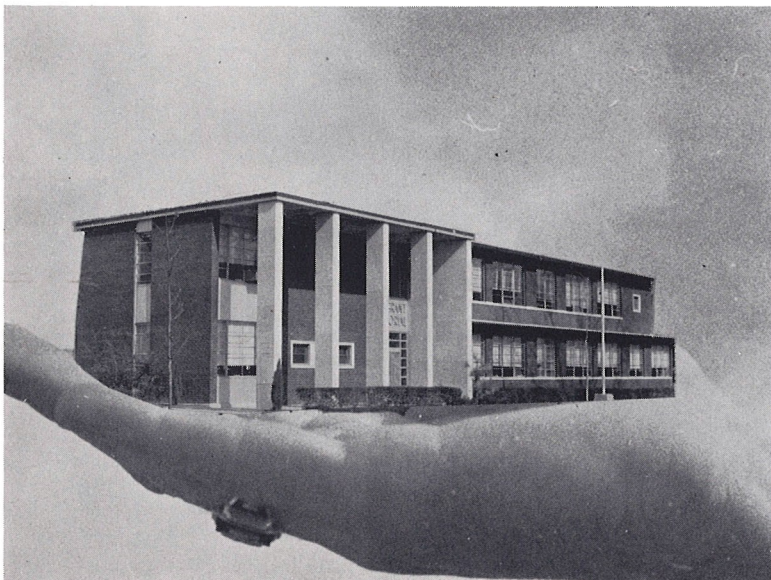
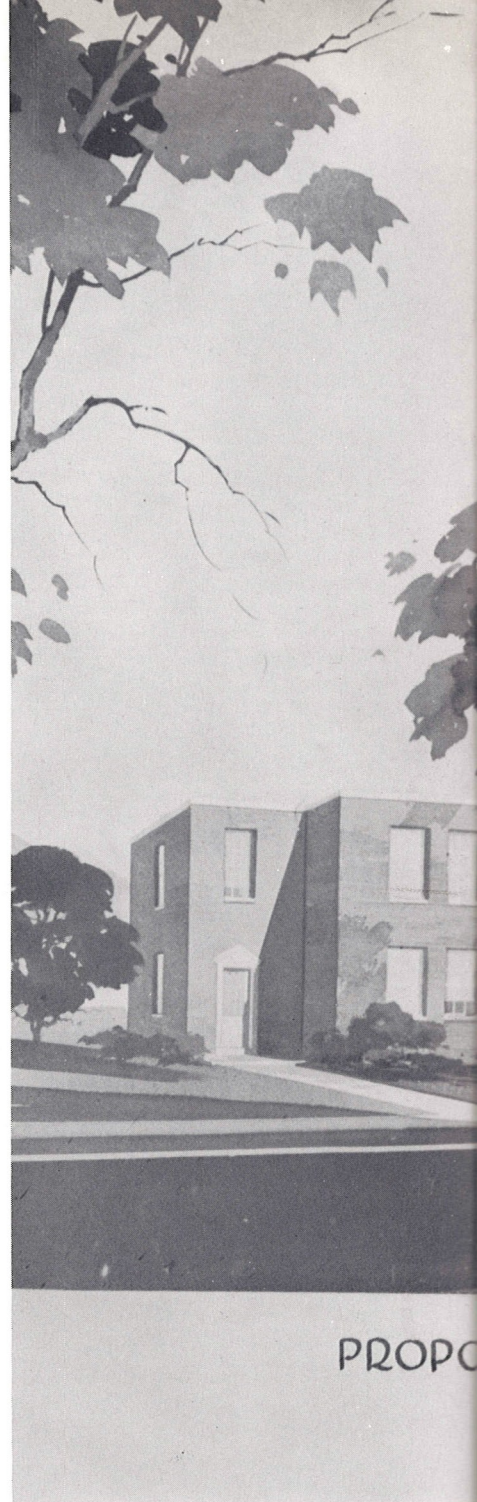

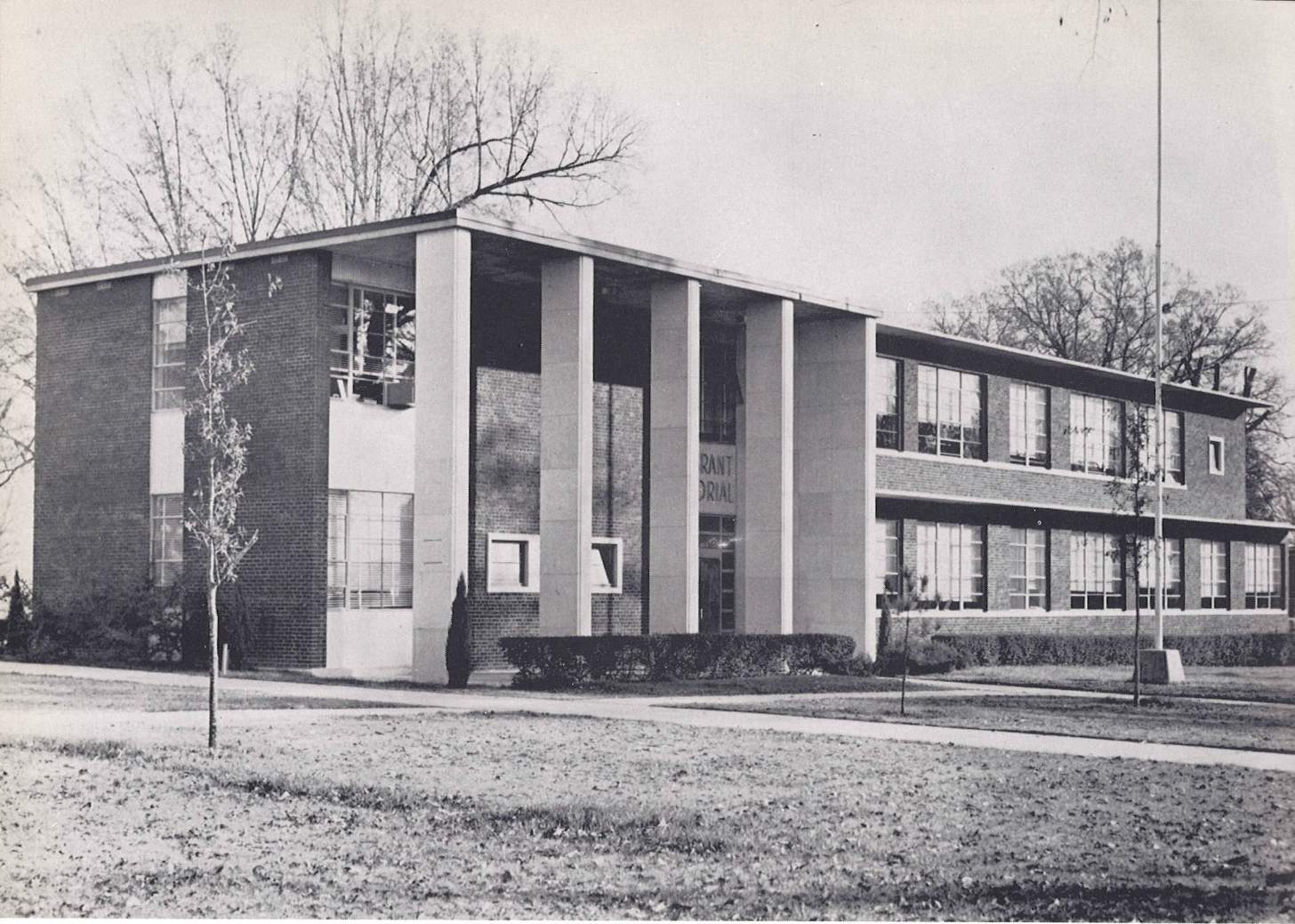




SED CHAPEL AND CLASS ROOM BUILDING

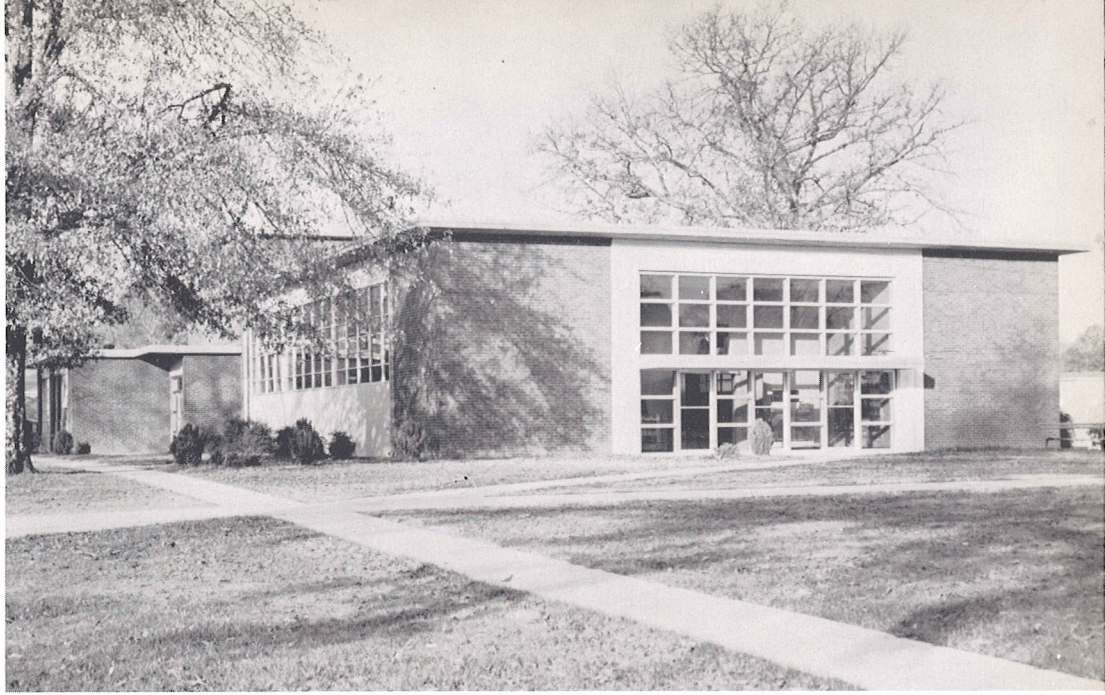

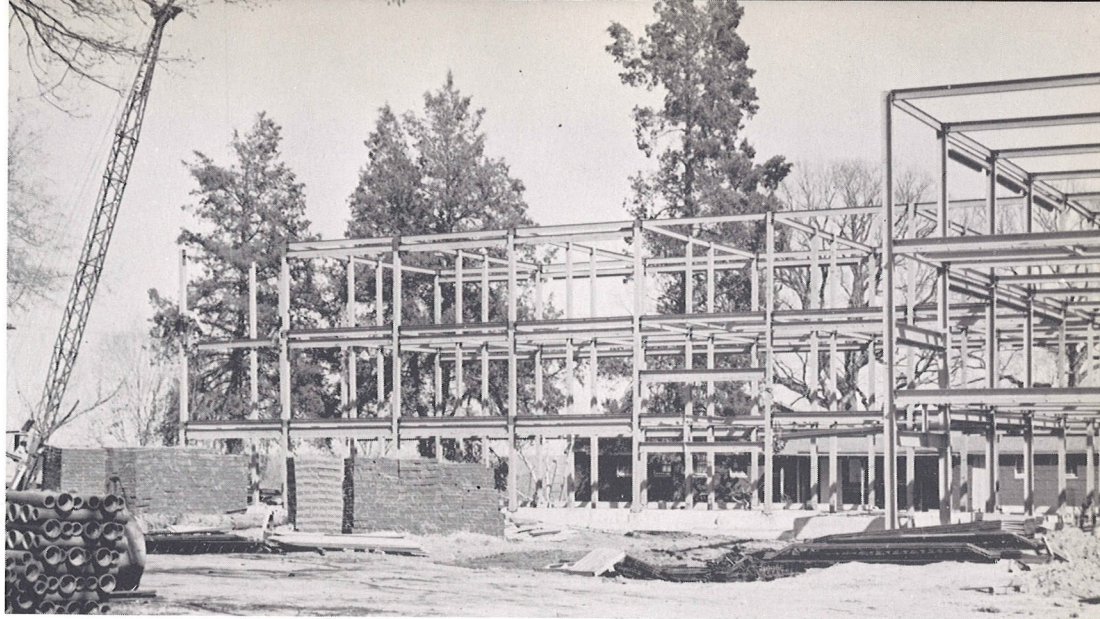




CONE-BOTTOMS HALL FOR WOMEN

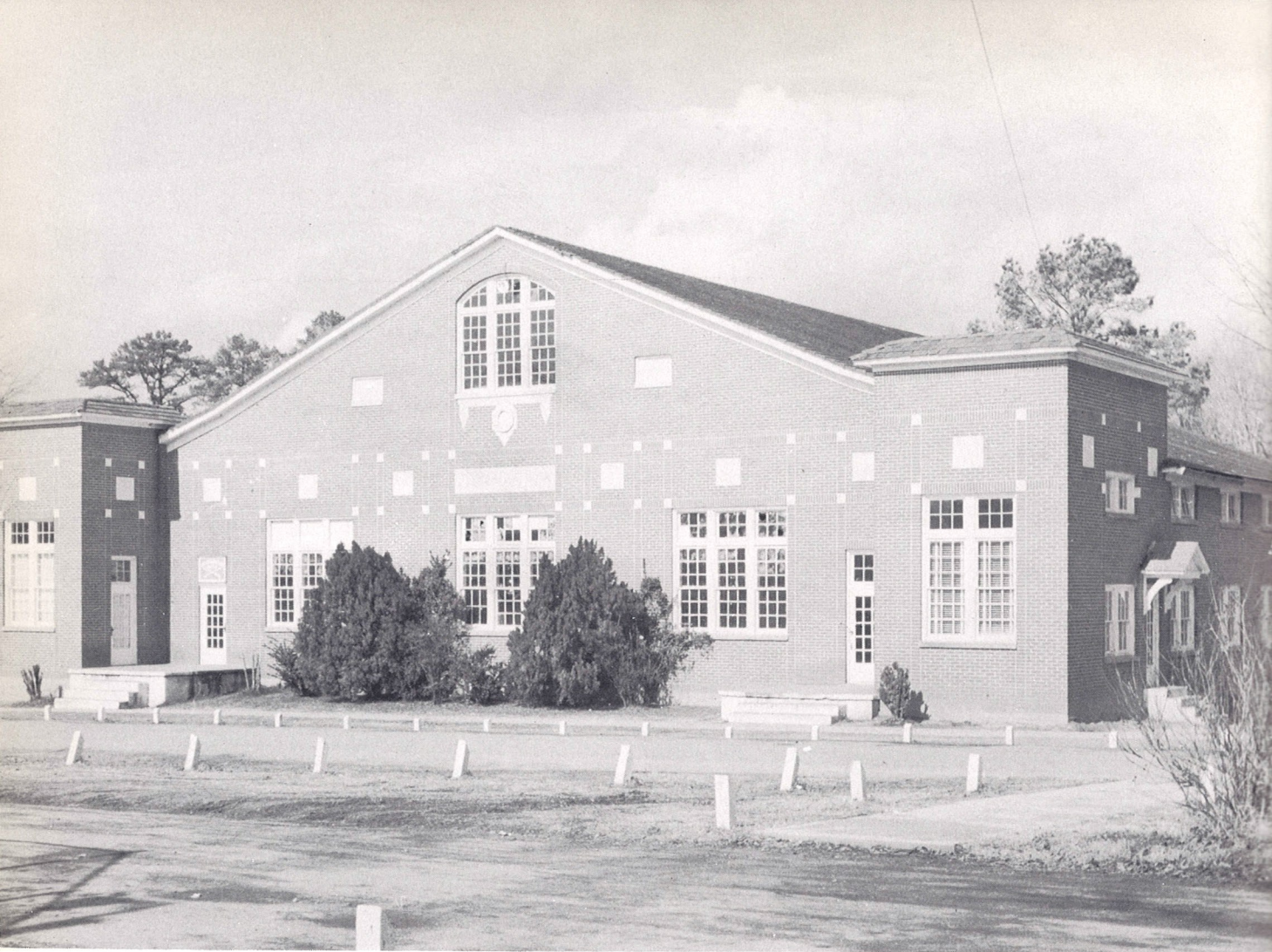

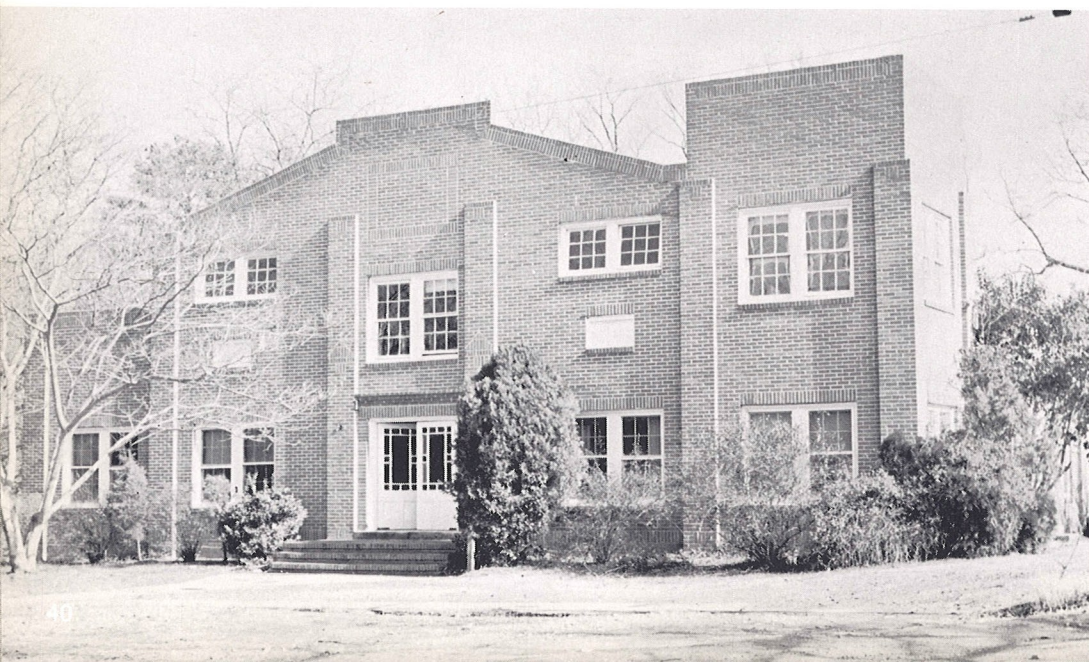

MANSION

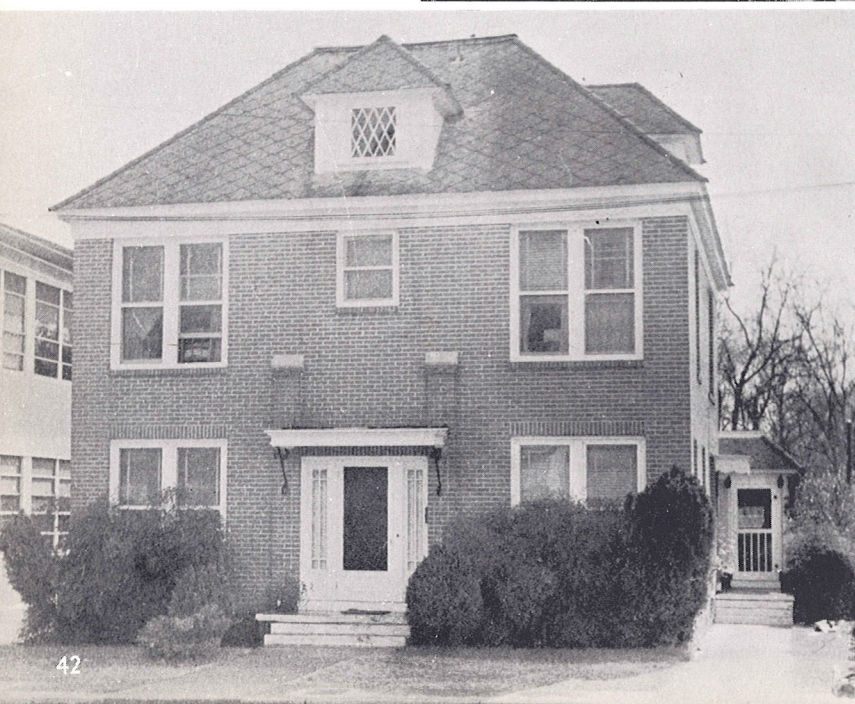
Formerly the home of the college president, the mansion is now serving as a dormitory for upperclasswomen. It is eventually to be razed to make way for the Bible building.
