### CONSTITUTION

NOTE: Due to the high cost of printing we are not printing the constitution this year. We refer you to the Minutes of 1957, Pages 26-32. No changes have been made since that minute was printed. For your convenience in determining the number of messengers you are entitled to, we are herewith printing Article III.

Section 2. Each church shall be entitled to a minimum of three messengers. One additional messenger shall be allowed for every 50 resident church members above 100. No church, however, may have more than 10 messengers.

## MISSIONARY'S REPORT

This is a report of my second year of service as your Superintendent of Missions. It has been a busy year for me, a year of increasing satisfaction and encouraging achievements in many aspects, but also a year of disappointments. I shall speak first of those things which have brought satisfaction and encouragement and finally I shall point to the areas where disappointments have been experienced.

I have assisted 25 of our churches in the search for a pastor, and preached in 37 of them during the year. I conducted 8 revivals in the churches of the Association, preached 162 sermons, conducted 28 prayer meetings, spoke at 21 Brotherhood, WMU, and Sunday School class meetings, and preached 24 sermons at meetings outside

the Association. There were 72 professions of faith in the services conducted by the missionary, and 48 additions to the churches by letter. During the year I traveled 12,000 miles on the field.

One of the most gratifying things I have done this year was to lead the Davis Chapel and Concord Baptist Churches to combine to form the Bayou Meto Baptist Church. This new church has acquired a three-acre site on Highway 5 in the heart of the area served by the two churches. The Association paid \$1,500.00 of the total \$1,600.00 cost of this new property. The missionary served the new church as supply pastor from February until July when they called Bro. Eugene Irby. They have made splendid progress and are moving the Davis Chapel buildings to their new location. Their new site is just three miles north of the Little Rock Air Force Base housing project of 1,500 families.

Another thrilling phase of my work this year has been that of helping pastor Darell Ross and the Forest Highlands congregation work out arrangements with four of our larger churches for the procurement of a loan of \$100,000 for the construction and equipment of their first building. First, Second, Immanuel, and Pulaski Heights Baptist Churches have each committed themselves to underwrite one-fourth of this loan.

Now to consider the less encouraging aspects of our work this year. I am greatly distressed by the failure of our churches to adopt the "two per cent" plan for support of our Associational Budget. For two years now we have been appealing to our churches for 2% of their undesignated receipts for Associational missions. A large number of the churches have adopted the plan, some going as much as 3%, but for the most part our stronger churches have not given us even 1%. Because of this we have not been able to accumulate the funds we need so desperately for the purchase of land in strategic new areas. Three new sites are urgently needed, but no funds are available. Nor have we accumulated anything toward the B. S. U. Center Building at the Medical School. We will be called upon for \$15,000 for this project within one year.

The two per cent plan of support for Associational missions is recognized Southwide as the minimum that the churches of a metropolitan area should give for their local mission work. It has been adopted by scores of our larger associations and is enabling them to expand into new areas as their population increases.

I sincerely believe there is a growing spirit of unity among our pastors and an increasing awareness that there is a task we can do only as we work together for the advancement of Christ's Kingdom at home and unto the uttermost parts of the earth.

## AUDITOR'S REPORT

This report was submitted to the Association in typewritten form and contained six pages. It was done by John H. Harp, Certified Public Accountant, a member of the Frazee, Fox, and Dodge



Accounting Firm, and a member of the Auditing Committee. The report was reviewed and approved by the other two members of the committee, viz, Udell L. Kendrick and W. V. Garner. The Association unanimously approved this report. A copy of this is held in the files of the Clerk and is open for anyone desiring to see it, but the Clerk thought it too voluminous to print.

### EXECUTIVE BOARD

November 11, 1957, the Missions Committee elected the following officers: Rheubin L. South, Chairman, Roy Hilton, Vice Chairman, and L. C. Tedford, Secretary.

Voted to authorize a call from the NEW CHURCH FOUNDATION members for the purpose of helping the Bellevue Church secure a new site.

Authorized the missionary to take out insurance on the office equipment.

December 16, 1957, The Missions Committee authorized the naming of a new committee on NEW MISSIONS AND CHURCHES, and the following men were named: W. O. Vaughn, Chairman, Arnold Teel, and Vernon Cruse.

Voted to accept a recommendation of the Missions Committee, that all money on hand in the Expansion and Missions Fund be made available for the Bellevue Church to buy lots for a new site provided certain lots be purchased.

January 20, 1958, voted to request the State Missions Department to continue help to the Bellevue Baptist Church in the amount of \$100.00 per month.

February 17, 1958, Authorized the treasurer to pay \$50.00 on a printing bill for the Union Rescue Mission operated by Purl A. Stockton.

March 17, 1958, set the date for the 1959 SCHOOL OF MISSIONS, which is February 15-27, and set the number of churches to participate in it at 60, which means 30 per week for the two weeks.

April 21, 1958, voted to ask Fred Hubbs of Detroit, Michigan, to serve as campaign director for our simultaneous revivals April 12-19, 1959.

Revised the action of the previous meeting in regard to the number of churches to participate in the SCHOOL OF MISSIONS from 60 to 40.

Passed a motion that we authorize funds to be made available to the approximate amount of \$4,500 for the Forest Highlands Church (formerly the Bellevue Church) to close a deal on purchase of some lots.

Voted to make a gift of \$1,500 toward the purchase of a building site for the Bayou Meto Baptist Church.

Requested the Arkansas Baptist State Convention to donate to the Association for a church site, a plot of ground near the junction of Remount Road and Camp Robinson Road.

May 12, 1958, set the date for a clinic on Forward Program of Church Finance as June 30, July 1, 1958.

June 16, 1958, approved a request by the Missionary that we urge every church in the Association to give no less than 2% and no more than 5% of the general funds of the churches for Associational missions.

July 21, 1958, took steps toward re-purchasing the property on High Street now owned and used by the Longview Baptist Church, for the purpose of operating a GOODWILL CENTER for the low-income families of that area.

Set the number of Associational rallies at one per month, thus giving one each quarter for the Sunday School, the Training Union, and the Brotherhood Departments.

August 18, 1958, heard a request from the Alexander Church that the Association pay for the Sunday School literature for the patients of the McRae Sanatorium beginning with October, 1958, as the Alexander Baptist Church was having financial problems making it impossible for them to continue this ministry.

Authorized the clerk to write a letter of appreciation to the First Baptist Church, Little Rock, expressing our appreciation for the good meals we have been served at our monthly business meetings, and for providing us quarters for the meetings of our weekly Pastors' Conferences.

September 22, 1958, approved a bill of approximately \$50.00 for Sunday School literature for the patients at McRae Sanatorium.

Heard the report of the Budget Committee and made some changes in it as recommended by the Missions Committee, and approved it.

Approved a recommendation from the Missions Committee that the new budget which will be submitted to the Association include an item of \$200.00 to cover cost of Sunday School literature for the McRae Sanatorium.

Approved a recommendation from a special committee named to study and make recommendation regarding the office of Associational Treasurer, which was that we have our missionary serve as treasurer and that he be bonded sufficiently to cover moneys handled.

Approved unanimously a resolution opposing the so-called "States Rights" amendment sponsored by Jim Johnson of Crossett, which is to be voted on in November.

## ANNUAL REPORT OF WOMAN'S MISSIONARY UNION

During the seventieth year of the history of Woman's Missionary Union, efforts have been made to enlist women and young people in activities to promote Christian missions through a program of mission study, prayer, community missions and stewardship. We now have 63 Societies, 21 Young Woman's Auxiliaries, 34 Intermediate Girls' Auxiliaries, 74 Junior Girls' Auxiliaries, and 84 Sunbeam Bands.

Organizational plans have been promoted through the Quarterly Rallies. Four such rallies were held at Calvary, Little Rock, Pine Grove, Jacksonville, First, and Baptist Tabernacle, with a total of 1,013 in attendance. There were 6 GA and 4 YWA Rallies with a total attendance of 1,518. There was a Coronation service at First Baptist, Little Rock, in which 267 Junior and Intermediate girls were recognized for the work they had done in Forward Steps.

There were four meetings for instruction for local leaders held, a leadership meeting, a mission study institute, and two work-shops for young people's workers.

Under the direction of the Associational WMU our women of the local churches have ministered through visitation, personal witnessing, Sunday School lessons, Bible reading, devotionals hymn sings, and refreshments at the University, County, State, and Fort Roots Hospitals, and at McRae Sanatorium and the Girls' Training School. We have supplied copies of Open Windows for the patients at McRae. We have bought new Hymnals for the Girls' Training School.

We are grateful for the progress which has been made in WMU work in our Association, but there is yet much work to be done. There are still 10 churches which have no WMU work either for their women or children. Therefore, in support of the Baptist Jubilee Advance, the Associational WMU has accepted a goal for 1958-59 of the organization of 6 new societies, 2 new Young Womans' Auxiliaries, 10 new Girls' Auxiliaries, and 8 new Sunbeam Bands, remembering our job of bringing to our rallies and days of instruction the very best helps, missionary talents, and inspirational programs, which we can make available.

#### BAPTIST STUDENT UNION REPORT

The progress of the Baptist Student Union has been good this year. We now have two full time B. S. U. Directors, Miss Juanita Straubie at Arkansas Baptist Hospital School of Nursing, and Jim Boyd as City-wide Director. The Association has helped to pay the salary and promotional expenses of the City-wide Director.

The B. S. U. at Baptist Hospital has had a particularly good year. There are 169 students in the School of Nursing. Of these, 129 are Baptist. In the past year there have been 15 girls baptized into the several churches that they attend. Highlights of the year's program have been: a fall revival last November with 51 decisions, 4 of which were professions of faith; Christian Focus Week in March with some of the outstanding student leaders of the South; attendance of several students at Student Week, Ridgecrest, and also the Baptist Youth World Conference at Toronto, Canada; and the annual Religious Emphasis Week, September 29—October 3, with Mr. Robert S. Denny as speaker. There have been many other activities of the B. S. U. in missions and other areas of work that are noteworthy.

The University of Arkansas Medical Center B. S. U. has a fully organized and functioning B. S. U. Council for the first time this year. From the student body of about 500 in the five different schools, about 140 are Baptist and Baptist preference students. (The exact statistics are not available for the new school year.)

A pre-school retreat was held at Ferncliff Encampment on September 5-6. This was in conjunction with the Baptist Hospital B. S. U. There were 60 who attended that retreat. Approximately 20 were from the Med Center and 40 from Baptist Hospital.

The Med Center B. S. U. raised \$100.00 for their contribution to the Student Summer Mission Program. This was twice the amount of their goal.

There is a good average attendance at noonday devotionals. The average is about twice what it was a year ago.

The B. S. U. at Little Rock University is in the process of being reorganized after several years of inactivity. There is a good bit of interest from the students, and complete support on the part of the faculty and administration. There should be a great deal of advance seen in the near future.

Also, there has been quite a bit of interest expressed about organizing a B. S. U. in our two business colleges.

### TRAINING UNION REPORT

We have 73 churches in the association and seven missions. Of these 80 organizations, 77 have during the past year carried on a Training Union program. At our Demonstration Week held at Second Baptist Church, Little Rock, we had a total of 23 churches represented with 298 enrolled.

### SUNDAY SCHOOL REPORT

Bro. Jim Cady, our Associational Sunday School Superintendent, was named Dean of Students at Ouachita Baptist College early in our year's work and the Missionary attempted to carry out the plans laid by Mr. Cady for the year. Not all of the Group Rallies were held as planned, but the quarterly meetings were held.

The Group Training Schools this year were the best in the history of Pulaski Association. Seven schools were conducted, 52 churches participated, the total enrollment was 1,213, the average attendance each night was 917, and 896 earned awards.

The V. B. S. Clinics were the best attended of any ever conducted by the Association. Two clinics were held, April 28 at Immanuel, and April 29 at Baring Cross. Sixty-seven churches sent 440 workers to these clinics. The handwork displays were the finest to be found anywhere, for which we are indebted to Mr. Paul Power and the All-State Supply Company, Tandy Leather Company, Rev. William V. Philliber, Mrs. Tommy Spencer, and our Baptist Bookstore.

We had the greatest number of Bible Schools conducted this year in the history of Pulaski Association. There were 60 church schools, 8 mission schools, and 2 Negro schools. The total enrollment was 10,753 and the average attendance was 8,578.

## HISTORICAL NOTES

**Amboy**, completed and entered a \$50,000 Educational Building in November, 1957.

**Bayou Meto**, was constituted February 23, 1958, as a result of Davis Chapel and Concord consolidating and agreeing to build a new house of worship at a central point. A site of three acres was bought on State Highway 5. Eugene Irby was called as pastor July 9, 1958.

**Calvary, L. R.**, bought a house and lot near the church for educational use and future expansion.

**Calvary, Rose City**, began construction on another Educational Building.

**Capitol Hill**, completely air-conditioned the auditorium.

**Cedar Heights**, sold \$15,000 worth of bonds to finance the completion of the new house of worship.

**Crystal Hill**, called Emmett Pipkins as pastor September 1, 1958.

**Crystal Valley**, completed and moved into a new auditorium.

**Forest Highlands**, was organized February 2, 1958, by a group of members from Bellevue after that church had dissolved. This church has purchased some lots on Mississippi Ave., and has made plans to build soon.

**Grace**, bought a house and lot adjacent to the church and converted it to use as an Educational Annex.

**Gaines Street**, completed a \$310,000 auditorium and held the first service in it May 4, 1958. Called Richard Perkins as pastor about October 1, 1958.

**Graves Memorial**, installed a new baptistry.

**Harmony**, called Jack Hogue as pastor.

**Highway**, built a \$15,000 pastor's home and initiated a bond issue for financing a new church building.

**Roland**, called E. F. Boyles as pastor.
