

Since 1888, two years after the foundation of Ouachita College, military training has been a part of the curriculum. The Ouachita military department has a colorful and outstanding history. Ouachita cadets acted as honor guard for the Men in Grey at the Southern Confederate reunion in Little Rock in 1911, and acted as part of the honor guard for President Taft in 1910. The R.O.T.C. men's rifle team has won the Governor's cup twice—in 1951 and 1953, and in 1955 was cited as an outstanding R.O.T.C. when twelve Ouachita graduates as a unit ranked highest in the Fourth Army area and topped the average standing among all schools represented in the Basic Infantry courses for R.O.T.C. graduates during the summer. The Military department sponsors the societies of the Pershing Rifles and Scabbard and Blade, the men's and women's rifle teams and the Military Band.
